- \$352/mbf

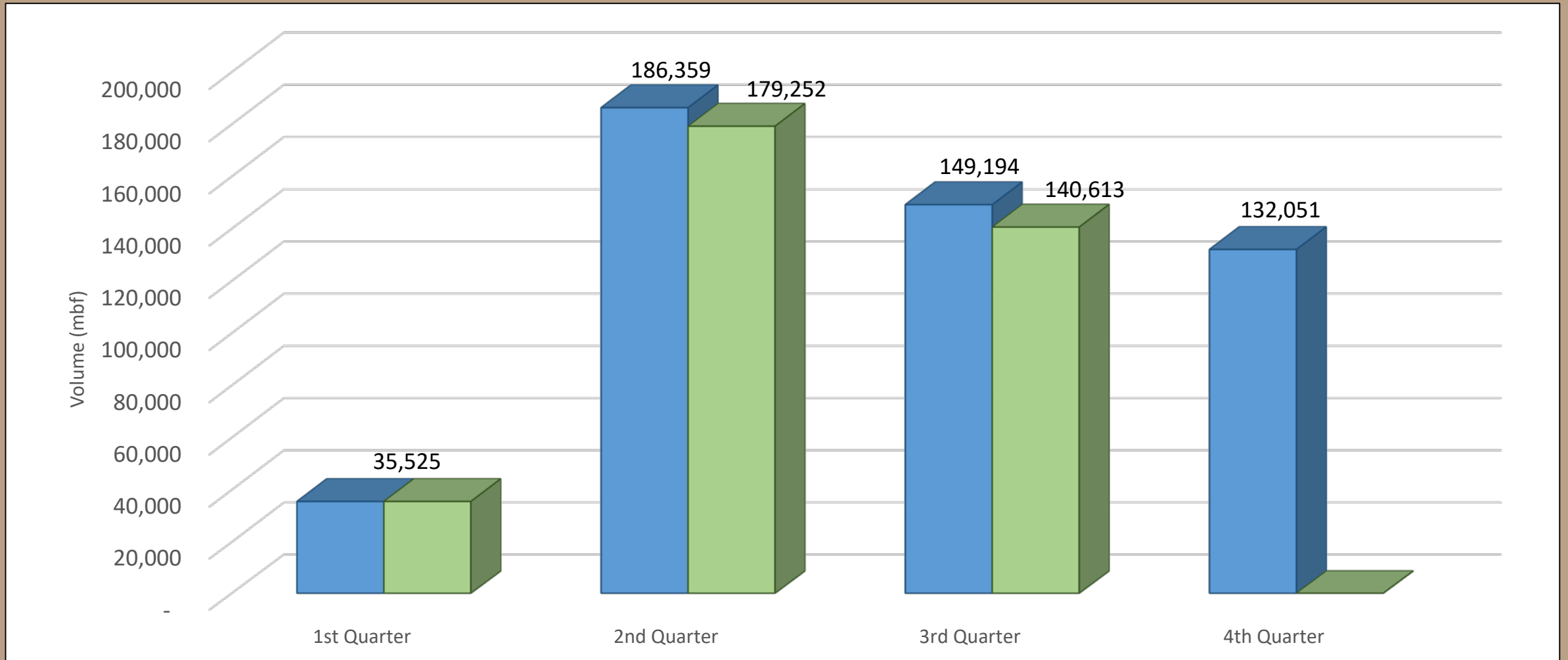
SALES SOLD

Fiscal Year 2018 Quarterly Volume

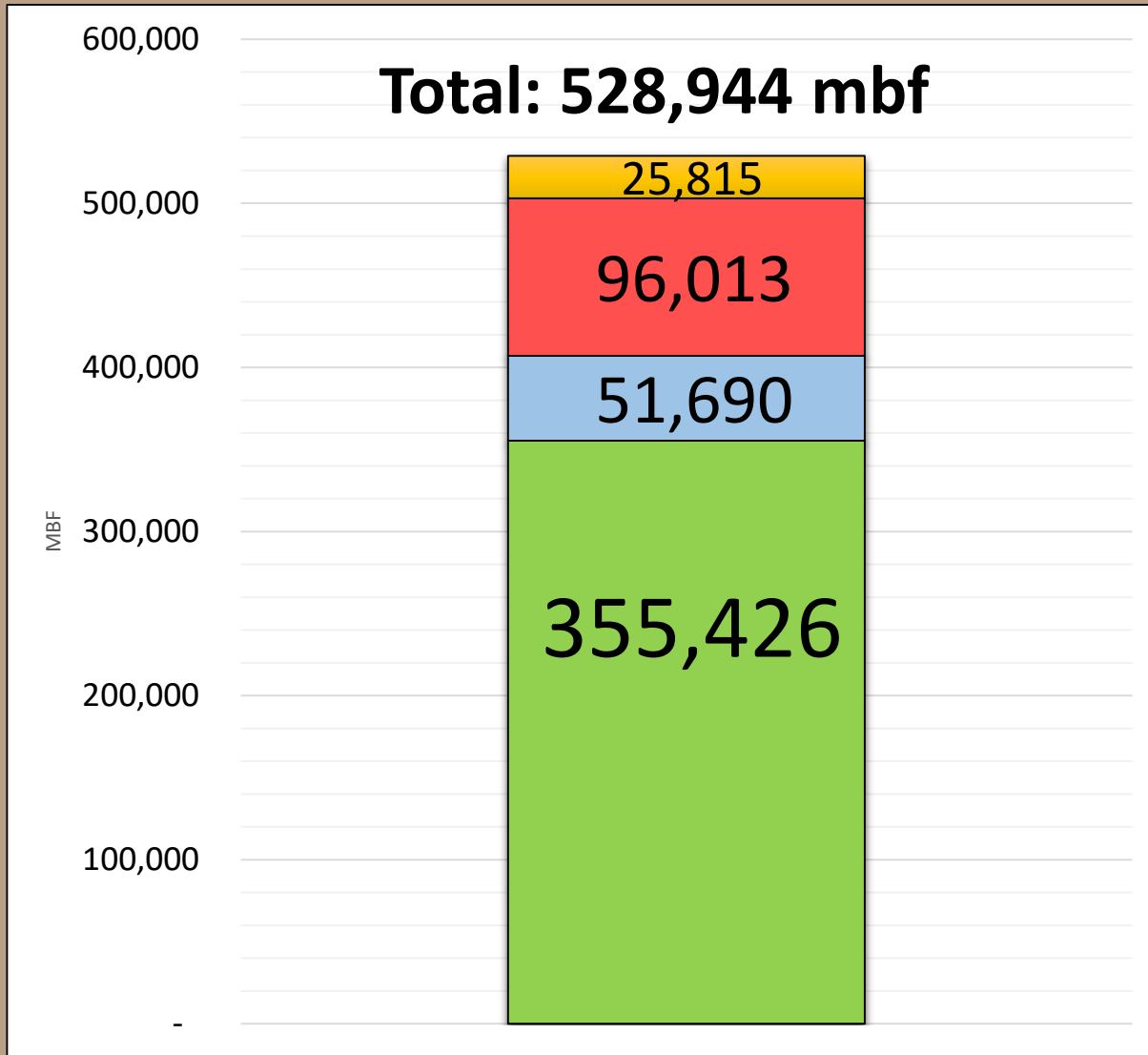
Planned* vs. Sold

Guiding Principles for Salvage Decisions

1) Retain pre-disturbance objectives

- Fiduciary
- Habitat

Simply operating under different set of conditions

2) Recognize that recovery of value materials or “salvage” is an economic activity

- Strive to minimize ecological impacts



Guiding Language

Statute: RCW 79.15.210
RCW 79.15.220

Determine if salvage is in best interest of the trusts, considering the financial value of the materials, as well as the physical and social environment

Policy for Sustainable Forests

Catastrophic loss prevention

Habitat Conservation Plan

Salvage is permitted in Northern Spotted Owl habitat management areas.

The goal is to **minimize** live tree harvest, **maximize and clump** retention of large, safe standing trees for future snags



Jolly Mountain Fire 2017

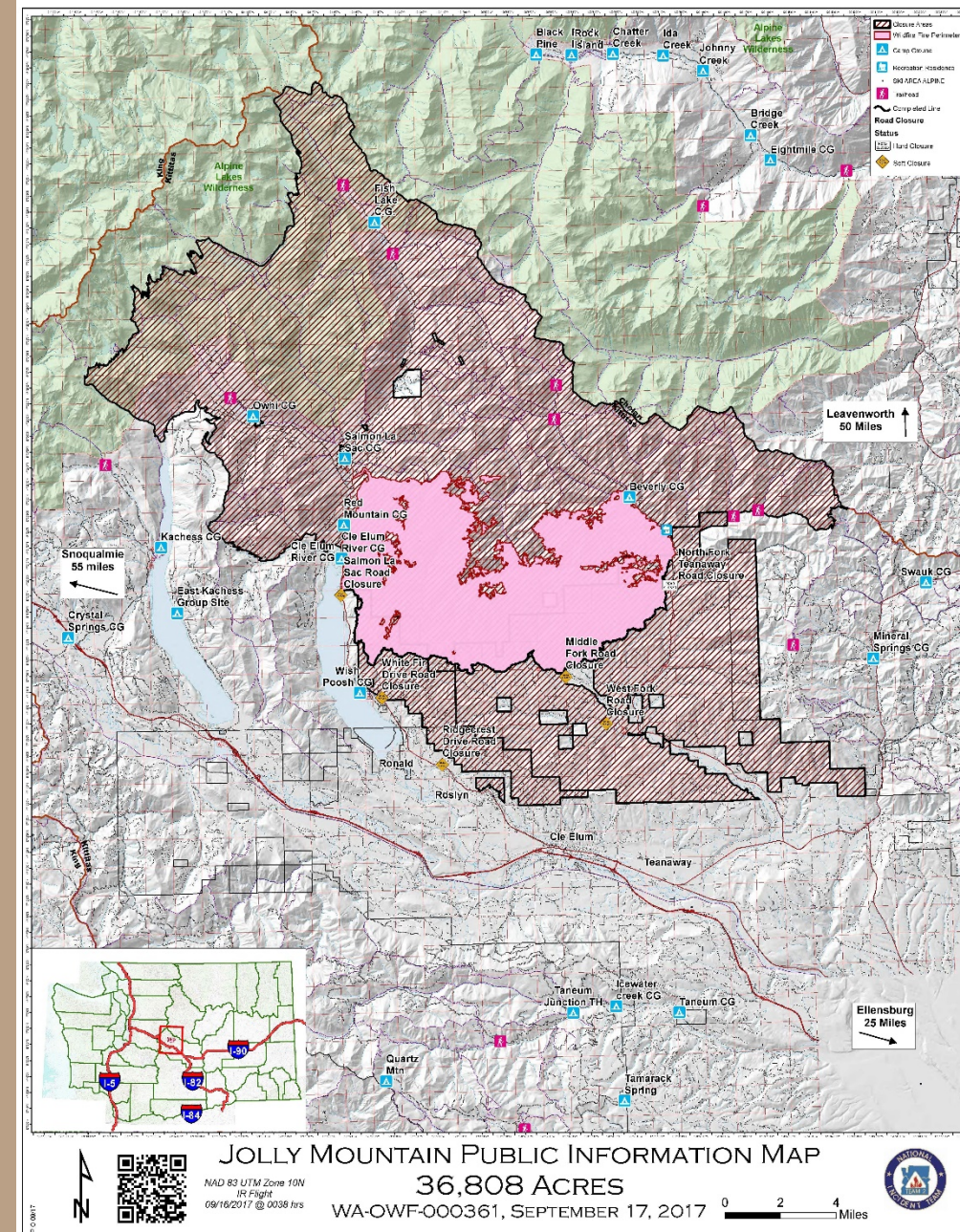
Central Washington

8,900 acres considered for salvage

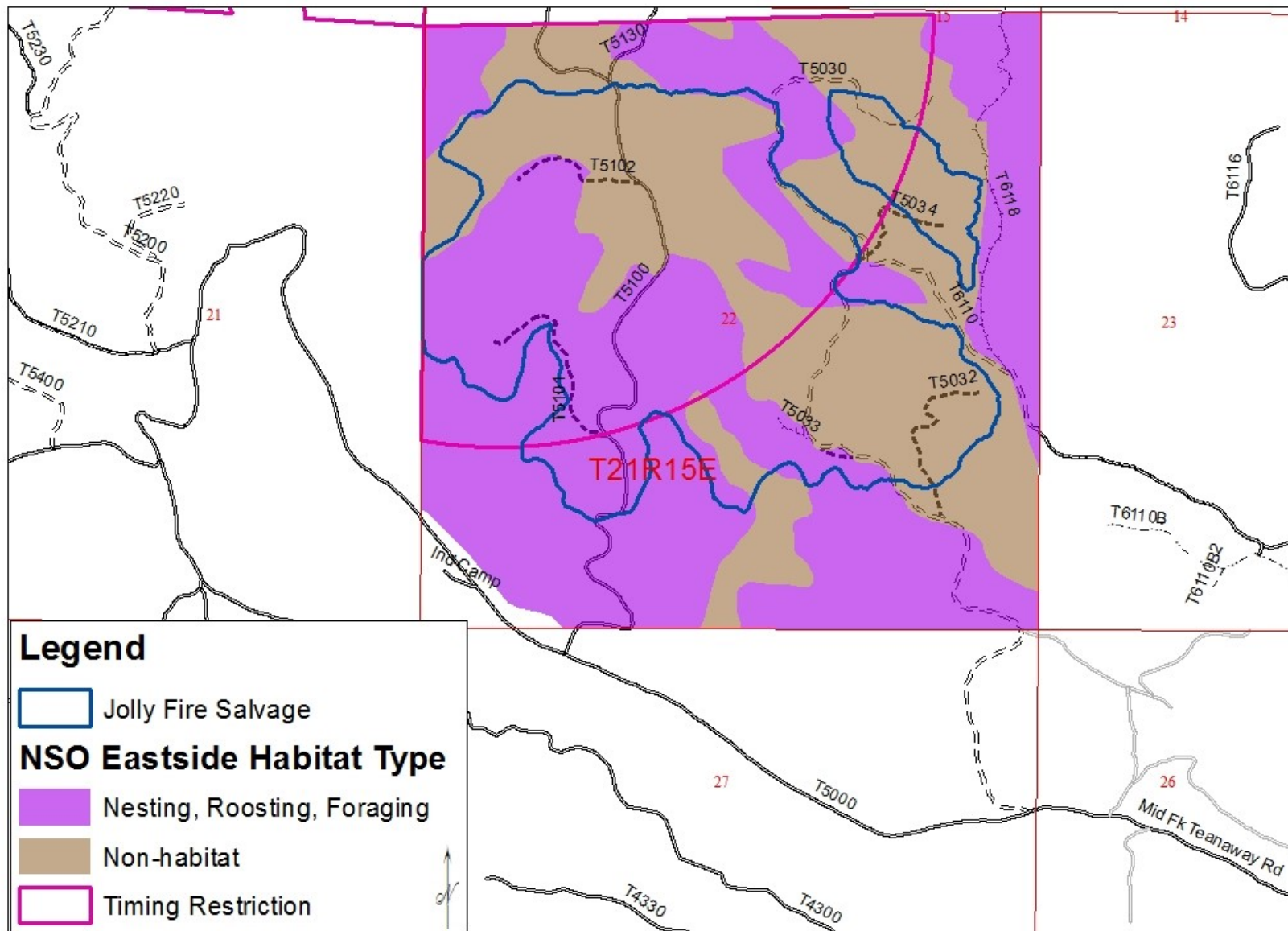
283 acres planned harvest
