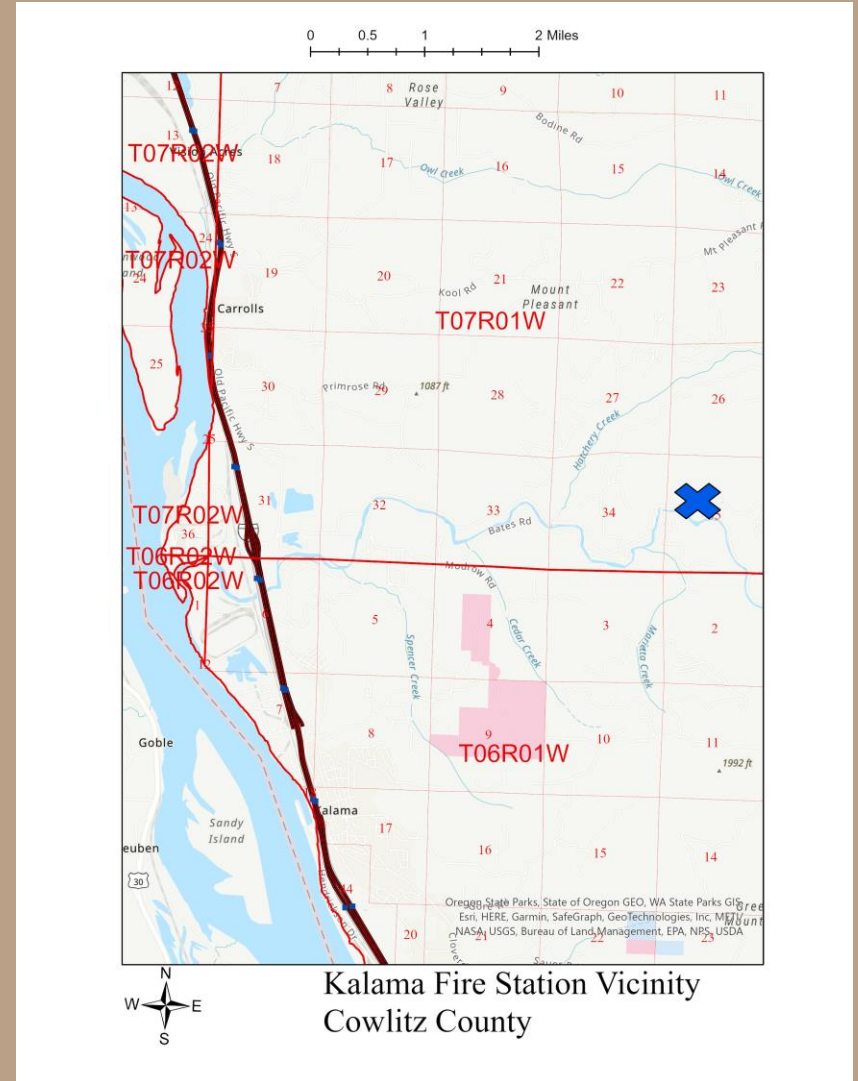
Fire Station Acquisition in Cowlitz County Administrative Site

Location

- Cowlitz County
- Approximately 5 miles East of Kalama, Washington
- Acquisition of an existing fire facility for wildland fire prevention and suppression support. Administrative site.

- Owned by Cowlitz County Fire District #5 and currently leased by DNR.
- Will be used to store 5 fire engines in winter.
- Replaces the soon to be closed Larch Mountain facility

- Close proximity to DNR property and road access.
- Creates new base of operations.
