Communication/Outreach Goals

- Ensure the public and recreation advocates receive the information they need to understand and participate in the recreation planning process
- Increase public understanding of the relationship between recreation and watershed protection and other community forest priorities
- Build long-term public support for the forest, including volunteer stewardship and adequate funding

Strategies

- Timely public information about advisory committee meetings and recreation planning process (DNR and WDFW communication offices)
- Targeted outreach to key stakeholders and recreation advocates in Kittitas County and across the state (DNR and WDFW staff and advisory committee members)
- Regular web-based communication about the project, especially around key planning milestones (DNR and WDFW communication offices)
- Outreach to news media in central Washington and to outdoor and environmental reporters statewide (DNR and WDFW communication offices)

- Number of E-newsletter subscribers
- Survey participation by wide range of interests: hikers, horseback riders, motorcyclists, and others
- Media coverage of planning process and opportunities for public input
- Meeting attendance
