

Rules Summary:

- Motorized vehicles allowed only on roads marked with a Green Dot.
- Limit camping stay to 10 days on DNR lands within a 30-day period.
- No vehicle camping or parking more than 100 ft. from a Green Dot road.
- Vehicle access to campsites further than 100' off a Green Dot Road will be designated with a white post with the words "Camping Spur."
- No removal of wood from state land without landowner permit.
- No fireworks or fire-causing devices.
- Propane-powered campfire permissible year-round.
- No permanent structures allowed.
- No removal of minerals or artifacts without landowner permit.
- Do not cut trees or snags. Down wood less than 12" diameter may be collected for on-site camp wood.
