DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE

Description of proposal: Richmond Fire Salvage Timber Sale, Agreement No. 30-106277 and Forest Practices Application No. 2942288. This is a variable retention harvest with 75 acres in 1 unit removing approximately 3,663 MBF of timber, with 2,840 feet of road construction, 220 feet of road reconstruction, 28,965 feet of pre-haul maintenance, and 1,287 feet of road abandonment.

Proponent: Department of Natural Resources

Location of proposal, including street address, if any: Sections 26 and 27 all in Township 14 North, Range 5 West, W.M., approximately 30 miles by road, West of Chehalis, off the L-3000 and L-3025 road systems in Lewis County, Washington.

Lead agency: Department of Natural Resources

The lead agency for this proposal has determined that it does not have a probable significant adverse impact on the environment. An environmental impact statement (EIS) is not required under RCW 43.21c.030(2)(c).
