- Located behind this sign, the launch is closed from early September to April to protect wintering waterfowl. Please check the rules posted at the launch, and be aware of the tides.
- Accessed by traveling southeast on Woodard Bay Road to the Chehalis Western Trail parking lot, this crushed-rock trail is closed March to mid-August to protect nesting birds.
