**Northbound on I-5**

- Take exit 195 (Marine View Dr.) on I-5
- Go left at the bottom of the off ramp onto E. Marine View Dr.
- Follow road until it goes under the overpass of Hwy 529 going north; road you are on becomes Hwy 529S (this road is also called W. Marine View Dr on some maps)
- Go past the Legion Park golf course entrance; take the next left onto Alverson Blvd.
- Take the next left into Legion Park and turn right at the parking lot. Entrance to the arboretum is at the far end of the parking lot.

### Southbound on I-5

- Take exit 198 onto southbound Hwy 529
- Follow Hwy 529 across the Snohomish River Delta bridge
- Take right at the first exit after bridge to Hwy 529S
- Bottom of the ramp at light turn left onto Hwy 529S (on some maps this road is also called W. Marine View Dr)
- Go past the Legion Park golf course entrance; take the next left onto Alverson Blvd.
- Take the next left into Legion Park and turn right at the parking lot. Entrance to the arboretum is at the far end of the parking lot.
