Service Reduction Definitions:

Facilities Removal:
 Sites will not have amenities such as outhouses, picnic tables, signs, and/or garbage cans. The public can still recreate in these areas, but they will need to pack out what they pack in. In many areas, gates to access roads will be locked, and the only way into a site will be on foot.

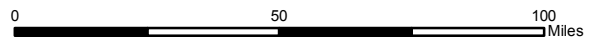
Seasonal Closure:
 Areas that were once open year round will be open only during high-peak season. Some areas with existing seasonal closures may have extended closure schedules.

Day Use Only:
 No overnight camping.

Reduced Services:
 Facilities are maintained at a lesser level than in 2008.

User Supported:
 Recreation users and groups agree to pick up more responsibility for maintenance and costs to prevent service reductions.
