Middle Fork Teanaway County Road

When: June 9 - July 10

What: Expect delays due to road maintenance on a 4.9-mile section of dirt road at the end of the Middle Fork Teanaway County Road. Delays will occur primarily during the work week, with minor delays on the weekend.

Recreation Affected: Road maintenance will limit access to Indian Creek Campground as well as access to US Forest Service trailheads such as the Middle Fork Teanaway (No. 1393), Yellow Hill (No. 1222), and West Fork Teanaway (No. 1353).

When: July 21 - August 31

What: Culvert replacement will limit access to the Little Jungle Creek Road.
