The public is invited to share ideas about the future of the Teanaway Community Forest.

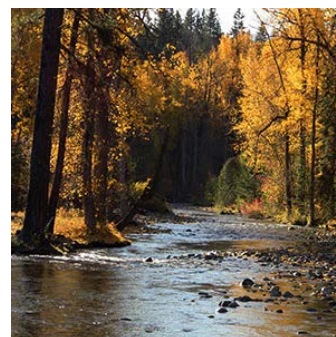

The Teanaway Community Forest will be managed through a partnership between DNR and WDFW, with input from the advisory committee, local community, and interested stakeholders.

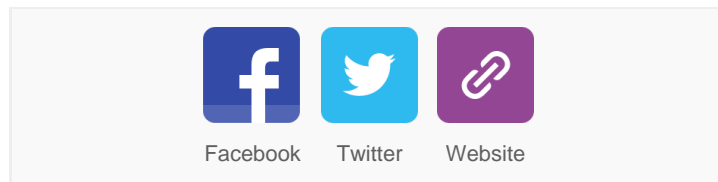
