3. When responding to question 1 (your lease plans), please include information regarding the following if applicable: Type of lease requested (e.g. commercial, agriculture, grazing, etc.); period of time requested for lease; improvement plans; type of crops; crop rotation; grazing plans; etc.
4. The Washington Department of Natural Resources consideration of the application includes a field inspection and an administrative review to determine the impact the request will have on the management of the lands involved and to determine if the request is in accordance with the statutes of the State of Washington.
5. State leases, to entities other than public agencies, require public advertising and a public auction.
