S-215 Fire Operations in the Wildland Urban Interface

Serving South Puget Sound Fire Defense Board Regions (Serving WA DNR, King, Pierce, Mason, and Kitsap Counties)

This course is designed to assist structure and wildland firefighters who will be making tactical decisions when confronting wildland fire that threatens life, property, and improvements, in the wildland / urban interface. A special emphasis to this course will be to assist all participants comprehend current structure protection and triage methods with field exercises in the community.

TARGET GROUP:

Structural Fire Departments: This training is appropriate for all firefighters/engine operators, company officers, and chief officers responsible for structure protection in suburban and urban interface areas that may be threatened by wildland fire.

Wildland Fire Agencies:

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

This course is NWCG certified and is interchangeable with the NWCG approved S-290 instructor lead training course. It can be completed in approximately fifteen hours (current average), but may vary depending on level of student knowledge.

S-290 is the second course in a five course sequence developing wildland fire behavior prediction knowledge and skills. It builds upon the basics in S-190, Introduction to Wildland Fire Behavior, but with more detailed information about characteristics and interactions of the wildland fire environment (fuels, weather, and topography) that affect wildland fire behavior for safety purposes.

OBJECTIVES

- Identify and describe the characteristics of fuels, weather, and topography that influence wildland fire behavior.
- Describe the interaction of fuels, weather, and topography on wildland fire behavior, fireline tactics, and safety.
- Describe the causes of extreme wildland fire behavior (long-range spotting, crowning, and fire whirls) developing due to fuels, weather, and/or topography.
- Interpret, apply, and document wildland fire behavior and weather information.
