## SUBJECT: SEPA LEAD AGENCY & DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE

This is to advise you that pursuant to WAC 197-11-900 (922 through 948), the Department of Natural Resources has determined that it is Lead Agency for the following:

Forest Practice Application #2819299 and Farm View VRH & SWT Timber Sale #104695 proposal is for an evenaged, uneven-aged, and right-of-way timber harvest of approximately 1,868 MBF on approximately 130.6 acres. The proposal includes approximately 5,755 feet of road construction, portions of which are in the Groundwater Recharge Area of a Glacial Deep-Seated Landslide. Located in Sections 04, 08, 09, 16, 17, Township 32 North, Range 06 East, W.M., Snohomish County.
