DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE

Description of proposal: DNR proposes to install a gravel parking lot, the ‘North Slope Parking Lot’ off of Highway 8 and the A-Line road in Capitol State Forest, adjacent to the North Slope Trailhead. The parking lot will be approximately 22,000 square feet and will replace the existing five-vehicle parking area with approximately twenty-two parking spaces.

Proponent: Department of Natural Resources

Location of proposal, including street address, if any: Capitol State Forest, A-Line Road. Near HWY 8 and Cooper Rd, McCleary, Section 16, Township 18 North, Range 04 West, W.M., Grays Harbor County
