



This sale contains Douglas-fir high quality and pole logs.

Non-tradeable leave tree areas are present in both Units #2 and #3 as shown on the Timber Sale and Logging Plan maps. There are differences with how these are marked between the two units: the non-tradeable leave tree area in Unit #2 is marked with double blue banded trees on the perimeter trees of the non-tradeable portion of the clump marked with yellow Leave Tree Area tags and pink flagging; non-tradeable leave tree areas in Unit #3 are marked with only yellow Leave Tree Area tags and pink flagging.
