Agency: Forest Practices Board	
Subject of possible rule making: The Forest Practices Board is considering rule making related to the decertification of Northern Spotted Owl site centers.	
Statutes authorizing the agency to adopt rules on this subject: RCW 76.09.040	
Reasons why rules on this subject may be needed and what they might accomplish:	
There is currently a moratorium on the practice of decertifying Northern Spotted Owl site centers as defined in WAC 222-16-010. The sunset date of the moratorium is December 31, 2008. New rules are needed to establish a temporary process (from January 1, 2009 through December 31, 2009) in which a three-person spotted owl conservation advisory group will evaluate requests for site center decertification. This temporary process will take place while the Board determines an appropriate long-term strategy for Northern Spotted Owl habitat conservation.	
Identify other federal and state agencies that regulate this subject and the	process coordinating the rule with these agencies:
