

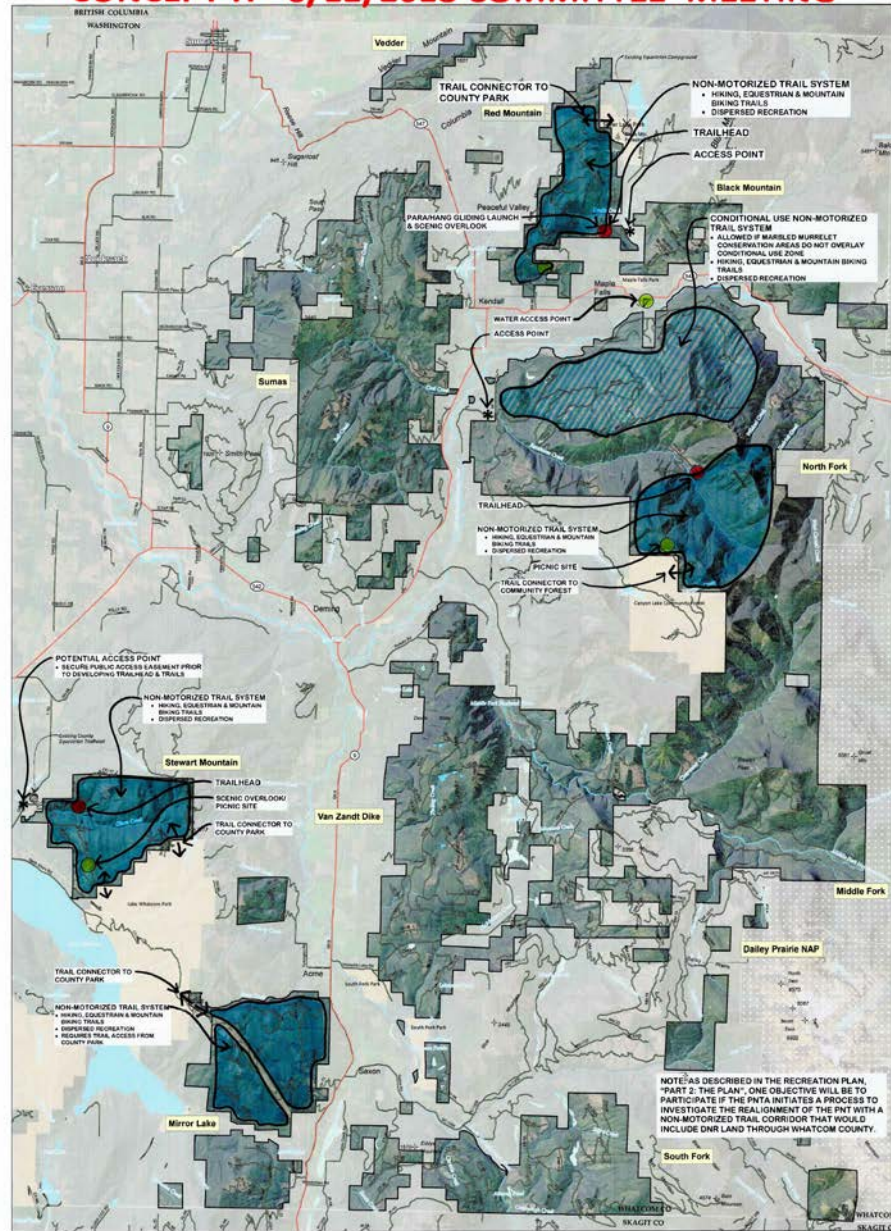

- All potential trailheads to non-motorized trails are subject to approval by the relevant state or federal land manager and will be developed only if approved by the Department of Natural Resources in this planning effort.

Public Access

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Objective A: Look for opportunities to provide public access to each recreation development zone in the Recreation Planning Area as compatible with timber management purposes.

Objective B: Use existing forest roads whenever appropriate to provide public access into recreation development zones.

Objective C: where feasible, establish and maintain certain level of service for roads to each trailhead location.
