DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE

Description of proposal: Coal Day VRH and RMZ Thin Timber Sale #30-099047 and associated Forest Practice Application No. 2421791; more than 200 acres considered for harvest was reduced to 163 net acres consisting of three variable retention harvest units and four riparian management thinning units, removing approximately 3,665 MBF of merchantable timber. Road work associated with this proposal consists of 40,327 feet of required pre-haul maintenance, and 20,160 feet of optional pre-haul maintenance.

Proponent: Department of Natural Resources, State Lands

Location of proposal, including street address, if any:

This proposal is located in Sections 18, 19, and 20 of Township 23 North, Range 08 East, W.M. This proposal is located approximately eight miles by road Southwest of North Bend off US Interstate 90, within King County. See the associated Forest Practices Application and driving map.

The lead agency for this proposal has determined that it does not have a probable significant adverse impact on the environment.
