



DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE

Description of proposal: West Fork Sorts Timber Sale No.30-107839. Forest Practice Application 3027410. This project proposes the sale of approximately 3,608 mbf of timber from 218 acres, construction of approx. 12,122 feet of road and installation of two culverts on Np streams.

Proponent: Washington Dept of Natural Resources Northeast Region State Lands.

Location of proposal, including street address, if any: the project area is located in Section(s) 5 & 8, Township 40 North, Range 40 East, W.M., located in Stevens County, Washington.

Lead agency: Washington Department of Natural Resources Forest Practices
