



## DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE

**Description of proposal:** The proposal consists of the salvage harvest an estimated 225 mbf of approx. 237 acres that was burned in the 2024 Goosmus fire. This review covers the Forest Practices Application (FPA) activities as described in FPA No. 3027509, and the Geotechnical Memorandum from Wild Goat Consulting, PLLC included with FPA No. 3027509.
