



DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE

Description of proposal: Q St Peter Timber Sale No. 107919. Sale of approximately 1,147 Mbf of timber on 105 acres, associated 1,999 feet of road construction, 156 feet of road reconstruction, 3,157 feet of road abandonment, 31,564 feet of road maintenance, and Forest Practice Application No.3027504.

Proponent: DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES
