## Changes in Operable Acres Used in the School District Analysis

The potential impact of the marbled murrelet long-term conservation strategy alternatives on school districts that have high proportions of low-income or minority student enrollment were evaluated using changes in operable acres (acres available for harvest) from the no action alternative (Alternative A) within a school district's taxing area. An explanation of how operable acres are calculated is available in Appendix M, "Data and Assumptions Used in the Socioeconomics Analysis."

Tables M-1 and M-2 present the percent change in operable acres for each action alternative from the no action alternative for school districts within the analysis area that have State Forest Purchase Lands or State Forest Transfer Lands within their taxing district(s). A few school districts that have raw acres of State Forest Purchase Lands or State Forest Transfer Lands within their taxing district, but little to no operable acres, were included in the analysis and also included in this appendix. Nine school districts had taxing districts within two counties; the acreage and subsequent changes in operable acres were calculated for these school district by combining the taxing district data. Student enrollment data for the 2017 through 2018 school year was obtained from the State of Washington Office of Superintendent of Public Instruction's Report Card report.
