This is to advise you that pursuant to WAC 197-11-900 (922 through 948), the Department of Natural Resources has determined that it is Lead Agency for the following:

**Crane Thin Timber Sale #107075 and Forest Practice Application #2819654 proposal is thinning harvest of 2,445 MBF from 322.8 acres. The proposal includes 4,511 feet of road construction, 9,777 feet of road reconstruction, and 55,396 feet of pre-haul maintenance. Located in Sections 23, 26, 27, 34, 35, Township 33 North, Range 05 East, Section 03, Township 32 North, Range 05 East, and Sections 19, 20, 29, Township 33 North, Range 06 East, W.M., Skagit and Snohomish Counties.**
