DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE

Description of proposal: Firefly CH Timber Sale, App. No. 30-096714 and Forest Practice Application No. 2816443. Variable retention harvest (VRH) of timber from 67.5 acres and variable density thinning (VDT) harvest of timber from 4.2 acres for a total harvest of 1,780 MBF of timber from 71.7 (72) acres. Proposal includes up to 802 feet of temporary road construction (road to be abandoned after completion of use, if built) and 29,037 feet of pre-haul maintenance.

Proponent: Department of Natural Resources

Location of proposal, including street address, if any: Sections 5, 6, 11, 12 and 14 of Township 36 North, Range 3 East, W.M. ; Section 36 of Township 37 North, Range 2 East, W.M. ; Section 31 of Township 37 North, Range 3 East, W.M.

Proposal is located 7 miles south of Bellingham, in Skagit County, off of S.R. 11, Chuckanut Drive and CX-ML forest roads.

Lead agency: Department of Natural Resources

The lead agency for this proposal has determined that it does not have a probable significant adverse impact on the environment. An environmental impact statement (EIS) is not required under RCW 43.21c.030(2)(c).
