This is to advise you that pursuant to WAC 197-11-900 (922 through 948), the Department of Natural Resources has determined that it is Lead Agency for the following:

Hootenanny Timber Sale #96781 and Forest Practice Application #2817521 proposal is variable retention harvest of 25.3 acres, removing approximately 1,423 MBF of timber. The proposal includes 1,435 feet of temporary road construction, (road to be abandoned after completion of use, if built), and 6,599 feet of pre-haul maintenance. Located in Sections 28, 29, 32, 33, Township 36 North, Range 07 East, and Section 06, Township 35 North, Range 07 East, W.M., Skagit County.
