SUBJECT: **SEPA LEAD AGENCY & DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE**

This is to advise you that pursuant to WAC 197-11-900 (922 through 948), the Department of Natural Resources has determined that it is Lead Agency for the following:

**Madera Sorts Timber Sale #100353 and Forest Practice Application #2817619 proposal a variable retention harvest and variable density thinning harvest of approximately 4,054 MBF of timber from 105.8 acres. The proposal includes 8,436 feet of road construction, 260 feet of road reconstruction, up to 6,937 feet of temporary road construction, (road to be abandoned after completion of use, if built), and 62,720 feet of pre-haul maintenance. Located in Sections 20, 21, 28, 29, 31, 32, Township 28 North, Range 09 East, and Sections 02, 03, 10, 11, 12, Township 27 North, Range 09 East, W.M., Snohomish County.**
