SUBJECT: **SEPA LEAD AGENCY & DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE**

This is to advise you that pursuant to WAC 197-11-900 (922 through 948), the Department of Natural Resources has determined that it is Lead Agency for the following:

Forest Practice Application #2616418 and Coyle Sorts Timber Sale #99251 proposal is for 142.2 acres of even-aged, uneven-aged, and right-of-way harvest of approximately 4,420 MBF of timber being removed using shovel, tracked skidder, rubber tired skidder, and leading end suspension cable harvesting methods in eight harvest units. The proposal includes 5,100 feet of road construction and rock pit expansion of approximately 0.75 acres. Due to potentially unstable slopes, the proposal is a Class IV Special. Located in Section 10, Township 27 North, Range 01 West, Section 22, Township 27 North, Range 02 West, Sections 10, 15, 16, 33, Township 26 North, Range 01 West, W.M., Jefferson County.
