SUBJECT: **SEPA LEAD AGENCY & DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE**

This is to advise you that pursuant to WAC 197-11-900 (922 through 948), the Department of Natural Resources has determined that it is Lead Agency for the following:

Forest Practice Application #2618095 and Ridge Run Timber Sale #103766 proposal consists of approximately 175 acres of even-aged harvest within 7 harvest units, removing approximately 5,629 MBF. Planned harvest methods include leading end suspension cable, cable assist, shovel, and full suspension cable. The proposal includes approximately 6,557 feet of road construction and approximately 31,000 cubic yards of spoils. Due to potentially unstable slopes, the proposal is a Class IV-Special. Located in Sections 11, 12, 13, 14, Township 31 North, Range 13 West, and Section 07, Township 31 North, Range 12 West, W.M., Clallam County.
