This is to advise you that pursuant to WAC 197-11-900 (922 through 948), the Department of Natural Resources has determined that it is Lead Agency for the following:

Hoh Mainline MP 19.4 Bridge TNC and Forest Practice Application #2616609 proposal is for road construction totaling approximately 1,248 feet and spoils deposits of approximately 105,000 cubic yards with 280 feet of road abandonment. The proposal includes two F crossings, including a bridge installation and a culvert removal. Due to activity on potentially unstable slopes, the proposal is a Class IV Special. Located in Sections 22, 23, 26, Township 25 North, Range 12 West, W.M., Jefferson County.
