DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE

Description of proposal: FPA/N 2616609 (Project Name: Hoh Mainline MP 19.4 Bridge TNC) indicates road construction totaling approximately 1248 ft and spoils deposits of approximately 105,000 cy are included in this proposal. Road abandonment totaling approximately 280 ft is also included in this proposal. Two F crossings are planned including a bridge installation and a culvert removal. Due to activity on potentially unstable slopes, the proposal is a Class IV-Special.
