SUBJECT: **SEPA LEAD AGENCY & DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE**

This is to advise you that pursuant to WAC 197-11-900 (922 through 948), the Department of Natural Resources has determined that it is Lead Agency for the following:

Homeward Timber Sale #101114 and Forest Practice Application #2616666 proposal is a ten unit variable retention harvest with 225 gross acres, and a cruised volume of approximately 4,527 MBF being harvested using ground-based logging methods. The proposal includes 16,925 feet of pre-haul maintenance and 1,870 feet of new construction is proposed to provide access to sale area. Following harvest, approximately 995 feet of road will be decommissioned. Located in Sections 16, 17, 18, 19, 21, Township 28 North, Range 14 West, Section 01, Township 28 North, Range 15 West, and Section 31, Township 29 North, Range 14 West, W.M., Clallam County.
