SUBJECT: **SEPA LEAD AGENCY & DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE**

This is to advise you that pursuant to WAC 197-11-900 (922 through 948), the Department of Natural Resources has determined that it is Lead Agency for the following:

Powerline Alder Timber Sale #100692 and Forest Practice Application #2616525 proposal is a variable retention harvest composed of one unit, 14 acres in size and located within the Salt Creek WAU. Total harvest acreage includes deductions for riparian and leave tree areas within gross traversed unit boundaries, with an estimated harvest volume is 246 MBF of timber using ground based operations with equipment and timing restrictions. The proposal includes 125 feet of required road construction, and 7,285 feet of pre-haul maintenance. Located in Section 05, Township 30 North, Range 08 West, Sections 31, 32, Township 31 North, Range 08 West, W.M., Clallam County.
