DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE

Description of proposal: DNR proposes to replace four variable length ORV trail bridges along the motorized trail system throughout Capitol State Forest. The new bridges will continue to maintain a positive hydrologic function and continue to reduce sedimentation downstream from sites, and three of the four bridges will be replaced with longer bridge spans.

Proponent: Department of Natural Resources

Location of proposal, including street address, if any: Capitol State Forest, off the B-Line and C-Line Roads. Near Highways 8 and 12, specifically:

Bridge 1: Section 20, Township 18 North, Range 03 West, W.M., Thurston County

Bridge 2: Section 12, Township 17 North, Range 04 West W.M., Thurston County

Bridge 3: Section 1, Township 17 North, Range 04 West W.M., Thurston County

Bridge 4: Section 16, Township 17 North, Range 03 West W.M., Thurston County

Lead agency: Department of Natural Resources
