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DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE

Description of proposal: Briskaet Timber Sale, Agreement No. 30-100214 and Forest Practices Application No. 2937901. This is a variable retention harvest with 151 acres in 6 units of variable retention harvest, and 2 acres of right of way harvest in 2 units, for a total of 153 acres in 8 units, removing approximately 6,211 MBF of timber, with 5,720 feet of road construction, 2,030 feet of road reconstruction, and 45,925 feet of pre-haul maintenance.

Proponent: Department of Natural Resources

Location of proposal, including street address, if any: Sections 28 and 29, Township 13 North, Range 06 West, W.M., approximately 12 miles by road, Southeast of Menlo, Washington, off the Mill Creek Mainline road systems in Pacific County, Washington.

Lead agency: Department of Natural Resources

The lead agency for this proposal has determined that it does not have a probable significant adverse impact on the environment. An environmental impact statement (EIS) is not required under RCW 43.21c.030(2)(c).
