SUBJECT: SEPA LEAD AGENCY & DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE

This is to advise you that pursuant to WAC 197-11-900 (922 through 948), the Department of Natural Resources has determined that it is Lead Agency for the following:

Choker Bell VRH & RMZ Timber Sale #105129 and Forest Practice Application #2942187 proposal is for a thinning and variable retention harvest, with 25 acres in 4 thinning units, 90 acres of variable retention harvest in 2 units, and 1 acre of right of way harvest in 1 unit, for a total of 116 acres in 7 units, removing approximately 1,788 MBF of timber. The proposal includes 1,378 feet of road construction, 1,910 feet of road reconstruction, 1,690 feet of pre-haul maintenance, and 1,377 feet of road abandonment. Located in Section 36, Township 12 North, Range 02 East, W.M., Lewis County.
