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DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE

Description of proposal: Schweitzer Timber Sale, Agreement No. 30-100724 and Forest Practices Application No. 2937846. This is a variable retention harvest with 134 acres in 5 units of variable retention harvest, and 4 acres of right of way harvest in 1 unit, for a total of 138 acres in 6 units, removing approximately 7,234 MBF of timber, with 6,155 feet of road construction, 37,200 feet of pre-haul maintenance.

Proponent: Department of Natural Resources

Location of proposal, including street address, if any: Sections 19, 20, 24 and 30, Township 13 North, Range 05 West, W.M., approximately 6 miles by road, Southwest of Doty, off the Nine Creek road systems in Lewis County, Washington.

Lead agency: Department of Natural Resources

The lead agency for this proposal has determined that it does not have a probable significant adverse impact on the environment. An environmental impact statement (EIS) is not required under RCW 43.21c.030(2)(c).
