



MITIGATED DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE

Description of proposal: The OAKRIDGE timber sale is an uneven-aged timber harvest on two sale units totaling 104 acres and even-aged timber harvest on two sale units totaling 48 acres, removing approximately 2776 MBF of State Timber, OAKRIDGE Timber Sale, Application No. 30-100091, and Forest Practices Application No. 2706960. Existing roads will be used and there are no typed watercourses within the proposal. There will be 150 feet of required road construction, 740 feet of required road reconstruction, and 1,761 feet of optional road reconstruction.

Description of mitigation: Maintain Dispersal Habitat for northern spotted owls on 104 acres of VDT treatments. The VDT units are marked and cruised including a leave tree cruise, to ensure dispersal parameters are met post-harvest.

Proponent: Washington Department of Natural Resources

Location of proposal, including street address, if any: Parts of Section 6 and Section 7, T4R11E, W.M. in Klickitat County.

Lead agency: Washington Department of Natural Resources

The lead agency for this proposal has determined that it does not have a probable significant adverse impact on the environment. An environmental impact statement (EIS) is not required under RCW 43.21C.030(2)(c). This decision was made after review of a completed environmental checklist and other information on file with the lead agency. This information is available to the public on request.
