



DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE

Description of proposal: The proposal is for an expansion of an existing Surface Mine Reclamation Permit (#70-012047) to increase the permitted acreage from 60 acres to 104.6 acres to include acreage that has been previously mined and to increase the approved mine depth from 150 feet to 250 feet below pre-mining topographic grade. The project would use imported clean fill to reclaim slopes and backfill to original grade. Approximately 20 million cubic yards of clean fill will be imported to the site. The site will be reclaimed to an industrial and commercial subsequent use.

Proponent: Pyramid Materials, Inc.

Location of proposal, including street address, if any: The proposed site is located at 8855 Dickey Road NW in Silverdale, within a portion of Section 19, Township 25 North, Range 1 East Willamette Meridian, in Kitsap County.

Lead agency: Department of Natural Resources

The lead agency for this proposal has determined that it does not have a probable significant adverse impact on the environment. An environmental impact statement (EIS) is not required under RCW 43.21c.030(2)(c). This decision was made after review of a completed environmental checklist and other information on file with the lead agency. This information is available to the public on request.
