DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE

Description of proposal: The proposal is for a new Surface Mine Reclamation permit (#70-013289) for a 22.03-acre mine. The proposed operations will remove aggregate material to a depth of 165 feet. Approximately 1.8 million cubic yards of onsite generated and imported clean fill will be used to reclaim slopes and backfill to near original contours. The site will be reclaimed to a rural residential subsequent use.

Proponent: Discovery Materials, LLC

Location of proposal, including street address, if any: The proposed site is located at 281240 Highway 101, Port Townsend, WA, within a portion of Section 13, Township 29 North, Range 2 West, Willamette Meridian, in Jefferson County.

Lead agency: Department of Natural Resources
