DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE

Description of proposal: Forest Practice Application #2421595, Pertnear Timber Sale 30-099045: This proposal is for approximately 58 acres of even-aged harvest with an estimated 3,405 MBF of timber being removed utilizing ground based, cable assisted or lead-end suspension harvesting. The proposal also includes two acres of rock pit expansion, 500 cubic yards of spoils and approximately 2,758 feet of new road construction and 2,288 feet of road abandonment. Forest Practices rule-identified unstable landforms are located adjacent to and within the proposed project area.


