**DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE**

**Description of proposal:** Forest Practice Application #2422920, Delica Hardwood #30-102086: This two unit proposal is for approximately 43 acres of even-aged harvest with an estimated 1,405 MBF<sup>1</sup> of timber being removed utilizing ground based harvesting methods. Forest Practices rule-identified unstable landforms are located adjacent to and within the proposed project area. The project will be using standard Forest Practices rules, which is a deviation from the prescription of the approved Kennedy Creek watershed analysis.
