**DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE**

**Description of proposal:** Forest Practice Application #2423217, Midtown: This proposal is for approximately 37 acres of even-aged harvest with an estimated 1,184 MBF<sup>1</sup> of timber being removed utilizing ground based and cable harvesting methods. The proposal includes 4,340 feet of road construction, two stream crossing installations in typed water, and approximately 1,500 cubic yards of spoils. Forest Practices rule-identified unstable landforms are located adjacent to and within the proposed project area.
