SUBJECT: **SEPA LEAD AGENCY & DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE**

This is to advise you that pursuant to WAC 197-11-900 (922 through 948), the Department of Natural Resources has determined that it is Lead Agency for the following:

Bumper Timber Sale #99077 and Forest Practice Application #2421865 proposal is a variable retention harvest of 244 net acres in nine units, and two associated right of way units, removing approximately 6,653 MBF of merchantable timber. The proposal includes 8,357 feet of optional construction, 442 feet of optional reconstruction, 47,258 feet of required pre-haul maintenance, 1,320 feet of optional pre-haul maintenance, and 3,239 feet of abandonment (if constructed, reconstructed, or pre-hauled). Located in Sections 17, 18, 19, 20, 22, Township 16 North, Range 04 West, and Sections 13, 24, Township 16 North, Range 05 West, W.M. Grays Harbor County.
