DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE

Description of proposal: Rad Aghast Timber Sale #30-105204 and associated Forest Practice Application No. 2424166; more than 171 acres considered for harvest was reduced to 90 net acres consisting of three variable retention harvest unit, removing approximately 5,442 MBF of merchantable timber. Road work associated with this proposal consists of 117,970 feet of required pre-haul maintenance, 1,550 feet of optional construction, and 1,550 feet of abandonment, if constructed.

Proponent: Department of Natural Resources, State Lands

Location of proposal, including street address, if any:

This proposal is located in Sections 22, 23, 26, 27, 34, and 35 in Township 17 North, Range 04 West, W.M. and Sections 24 in Township 17 North, Range 05 West, W.M. This proposal is located approximately 9 miles by road west of Littlerock, Washington off Interstate 5, within Grays Harbor and Thurston Counties. See the associated Forest Practices Application and driving map.

Lead agency: Department of Natural Resources, State Lands

The lead agency for this proposal has determined that it does not have a probable significant adverse impact on the environment.
