Dear Vivian,

The City of Seattle is requesting a 1-year extension of DNR Permit No. 20-089981 for SPD's use of Waterway 20 – Harbor Patrol site and adjacent uplands.

The requirements of the permit have been met, including the Phase II Environmental Assessment Plan and the development of the Conceptual Plan for potential division of the property for public access.

Additional time was required for the City to fund, contract, and complete the supplemental Phase II sampling and scoping requested by DNR/Ecology during the August 17, 2023 Phase II comment review meeting. The additional sampling was completed in January 2024 and the report was provided to DNR and Ecology for review and comment. All comments were reviewed and finalized in a joint meeting between the City, Herrera, DNR and Ecology on May 6, 2024. Herrera is finalizing the Phase II report, which DNR has advised will inform the State's long-term management goal of balancing Harbor Patrol's exclusive use, with public access to Waterway 20. The 1-year extension will be utilized by the stakeholders for this planning effort.
