The Department of Permitting and Environmental Review grants an extension of the date of expiration for Shoreline Conditional Use Permit SHOR13-0021 and Shoreline Substantial Development Permit SHOR13-0022 for one year to November 25, 2019, as you requested by letter dated February 1, 2018.

The effective date of a shoreline permit is the date of the last action required on the shoreline permit and all other government permits and approvals that authorize the development to proceed. In this case, the final action was a Corps of Engineers Individual Permit approved on November 25, 2014. Therefore, the extension is valid through November 25, 2019.

The shoreline permits were granted to allow implementation of Washington State's Moorage Buoy Management Plan to place up to 200 buoys in Quartermaster Harbor and remove unauthorized buoys. Once the plan is fully implemented, the Department of Natural Resources will not need additional shoreline permits to continue to manage the moorage buoy field.
