- 1. What affects will the project have on drinking water wells near the cove?
- 2. How many fish will the restoration produce?
- 3. Will the inlet/outlet channel fill in over time?
- 4. How will the project change water surface elevations? How will this impact homeowners?
- 5. How will the project affect the existing habitat and species in the cove?
- 6. How will the project affect recreation in the cove?
- 7. What options are there to restore fish passage without creating a large open channel (as shown on 1950's air photos)?
- 8. How will sediment movement, deposition and erosion along the beach and in the cove change?
- 9. How much water will be in the cove at low tide?
- 10. Can fish passage be provided with a fish ladder?
- 11. How will the project affect transportation? Who will pay for new transportation infrastructure?
- 12. What is the target for the number of fish using the restored site?
