Condition of the vessel

- Dismal (vessel hull compromised, subject to water infiltration, would sink quickly if left unattended)
- **Poor** (vessel doesn't operate as built, sailboat without mast, power boat without engine)
- **Fair** (vessel still has most of its major parts but is run down and functionally obsolete)
- **Good** (vessel still operates as intended, in seaworthy condition = **not eligible**)

I declare that, to the best of my knowledge and belief, the information contained in this application is true, correct, and complete. I understand that the Washington State Department of Natural Resources (DNR) or its designee may verify that the information provided in this application, including the Affidavit of Insufficient Resources, is true and correct. If DNR finds my statement in the Affidavit of Insufficient Resources to be false, I agree to reimburse DNR for all reasonable and auditable costs incurred for the removal and disposal of my vessel. These costs include, but are not limited to, costs incurred in storing, stripping, using, auctioning, selling, salvaging, scrapping, or disposing of the vessel, removal and disposal costs, all administrative costs incurred by DNR associated with the vessel, and costs associated with environmental damages directly or indirectly caused by the vessel. I understand that DNR may also pursue any additional remedies allowed by law.
