Policy Meeting Report: Cramer

- 1. Policy Budget Workshop is scheduled for September 27, 2007, OB2. Discussion items include, but are not limited to: funding strategy; migrating from federal funding to state funding, revenue streams, etc.
- 2. CMER Membership Policy Caucus Groups are looking at cleaning up their caucus lists. Cramer will submit the new list to the Forest Practices Board at their September meeting for approval.
- **3.** Fish Passage Sub-Group Former ISAG members are updating (as needed) the Flume and Stream Simulation study designs and drafting peer review questions

CMER Budget: Cramer

Handed out updated FY 08 CMER Budget table that was going to the FP Board on July 25, 2007. Master budget sheet will be forwarded to CMER once the FY '07 expenditures are reconciled.

ISPR Update: Cramer

- 1. Post-Mortem Study Design conference call scheduled for August 1, 2007. Three of the 5 reviewers will take part in that call. Darin_and UPSAG will follow-up with the other 2 reviewers if necessary at a later date. Following receipt of the formal reviews, UPSAG will prepare a response action plan for CMER review/approval.
 - 2. Fish Passage Once questions are drafted and approved by CMER, the two fish passage study designs will proceed to peer review.
 - 3. Intermittent Stream Study Design will be coming to CMER in August. Decision to move to ISPR will be made at that time.

SAG Requests

SAGE – Eastern Washington Type F Riparian Assessment Project requests to move \$85,000 from Tier Two to Tier One. CMER approved and the request will go to Policy at their August meeting.

SAG Issues:

- 1. CMER Staff Position The vacant position description has been drafted and will be coming to CMER in August.
- RMZ Of all the reviewers, only one CMER member is reviewing the document in its entirety. It will then be going to ISPR. Reviewers are finding many grammatical errors and will send it back to the contractor for editing. This may delay receipt of the east side chapters for a few weeks.
- 3. Document classification Will add a new category entitled "Policy-Directed Study". A new draft will come to CMER in August and then on to the September Policy meeting.
- 4. Site Selection Need to meet with Caucus groups to remind them of the commitment made to these studies. Sally and Darin will meet with WFPA, WFFA, and other groups to review the site selection issue and their previous commitments. Update on outreach will be on the August CMER agenda
- 5. Intensive Monitoring Sent our Version 4 of the scoping document. Reviews are due by the end of July. CMER will see the final at their August meeting.
- 6. Policy needs to be aware that more participation is needed at certain SAGs,.

CMER Workplan: Sturhan

The Workplan with track changes will be sent out to CMER. Nancy would like changes by August 15. CMER will review at the August meeting.

'09 Workplan: Cramer

Cramer presented a draft outline for potential changes to the '09 workplan. The reasoning behind this is to use it as a better tool for internal and external coordination on the projects. It is more critical to do this with the possibility of less funding in the future. It will keep better track of what we've done, what we're doing and where we are going with the projects. A small group will get together and work on a draft to present to Policy in September.
