SUBJECT: 2009 Rule Making Schedule

Following is an update on each rule making.

<u>Desired Future Condition</u> – Rule making hearings were held in December and January. At the February meeting, Chuck Turley and Lenny Young will present three proposals for your consideration for a permanent rule.

<u>Desired Future Condition – Fixed Width</u> - Staff has developed some concepts and continues to work with stakeholders for an agreement.

<u>Trees and Houses</u> – Staff continues to address comments received during the 30-day comment period and working with stakeholders to refine the rule proposal. Staff anticipates a rule proposal for your consideration at the May meeting.

<u>Northern Spotted Owl Rule Making</u> – The emergency rule that was approved at your December special meeting became effective January 1, 2009. The CR-101 for the permanent rule was filed with the Office Code Reviser on December 29, 2008. At your February meeting staff will request your approval to proceed with the 30-day review for permanent rule making with the same language as the emergency rule.

<u>Chapters 222-20 & 46 WAC</u> – Staff has begun rule development to reorganize chapter 222-20 WAC and to implement 2007 legislation pertaining to conversions. Staff anticipates presenting a recommendation at your May meeting to consider filing a CR101.
